Directions to Eastern Idaho State Fairgrounds

97 Park St Hwy 91-191, Blackfoot ID 83221

From North: Travel I-15 to Exit 93, turning east toward Blackfoot. Follow signs to the Eastern Idaho State Fairgrounds, but get into the left lane for approx 1/3 mile as the road will curve left. Go right onto Judicial St. Travel approximately 0.9 miles, turning left onto W Main (Hwy 91) and stay in the left lane. Go ½ mile and you will see the fairgrounds on the left. Make 1st left after fairgrounds onto Highland, then make immediate left onto Jones St following Jones for 1/3 mile and entrance on the left.

From South: Travel I-15 to Exit 89. Turn north to Hwy 91 toward Blackfoot. After 2 miles, you will enter Blackfoot. The road will widen to 2 lanes, stay in the left lane. After approx 1 mile, the road will curve right then back left. You will go straight through 2 traffic lights. After approx ½ mile, the fairgrounds will be on the left. Make the 1st left past the fairgrounds onto Highland. Make an immediate left onto Jones St and follow for approx 1/3 mile, and the entrance will be on the left.

List of Breeds Eligible to Enter

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Medio Portuguese Podengos, Grande Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Sloughis, Scottish Deerhounds, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the AKC or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered. Breed disqualifications apply.

General Information

Hounds must be one year or older on the day of the test. All hounds will run one at a time unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Spayed or neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Battery powered continuous loop machine will be used. Backup equipment will be available. Lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or strips of fur. Any hound that displays aggressive behavior during trial hours will be excused for the day. A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.

- ▶ The Fall weather can be unpredictable. We can have a mild, warm sunny day that may change suddenly to cold, windy and rainy or snow. Anything goes from shorts to parkas.

Tests Offered

Junior Courser - Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard (minimum) course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete that course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Stakes Offered

OPEN: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed that have obtained AKC Junior Courser Title or AKC Field Champion Title. Hounds that are disqualified from AKC Field Trials may not be entered.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship Title. No championship points are awarded from this stake.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and have reached veteran age on the day of the trial (5 years for IW's, 6 years of all other breeds). Championship points will be awarded.

BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED BOTH DAYS

Note: Azawakhs, Italian Greyhounds, Portuguese Podengos, Sloughi, and Thai Ridgebacks are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

All Best-of-Breed winners, with the exception of Italian Greyhounds, shall be eligible to compete in the Best-of-Field competition.

Additional Information

- ▶ All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- ▶ Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused.
- ▶ Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period.
- ▶ Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.
- ▶ Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.
- ▶ Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.
- ▶ The members of the *Pocatello Kennel Club Lure Coursing* reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.
- ▶ A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.
- ▶ PKCLC assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these Tests/Trials.
- ▶ Please bring your own food, shade and water, as this is an isolated site.
- ▶ **Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted.**

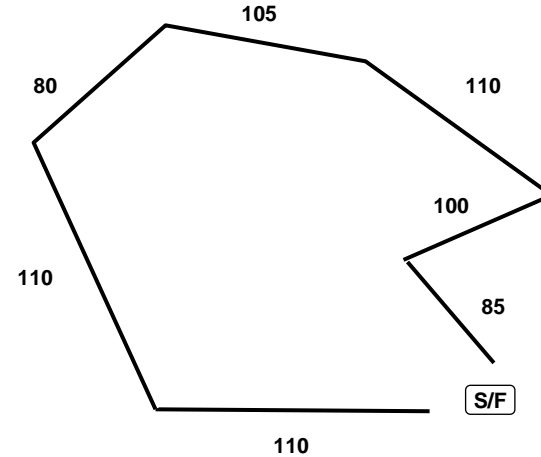

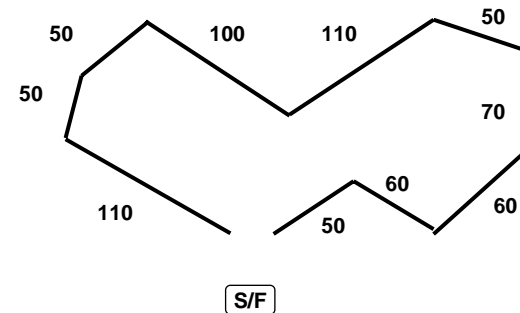
Course Plans
